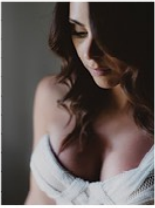
Another vendor that scored two very enthusiastic thumbs up from Kim

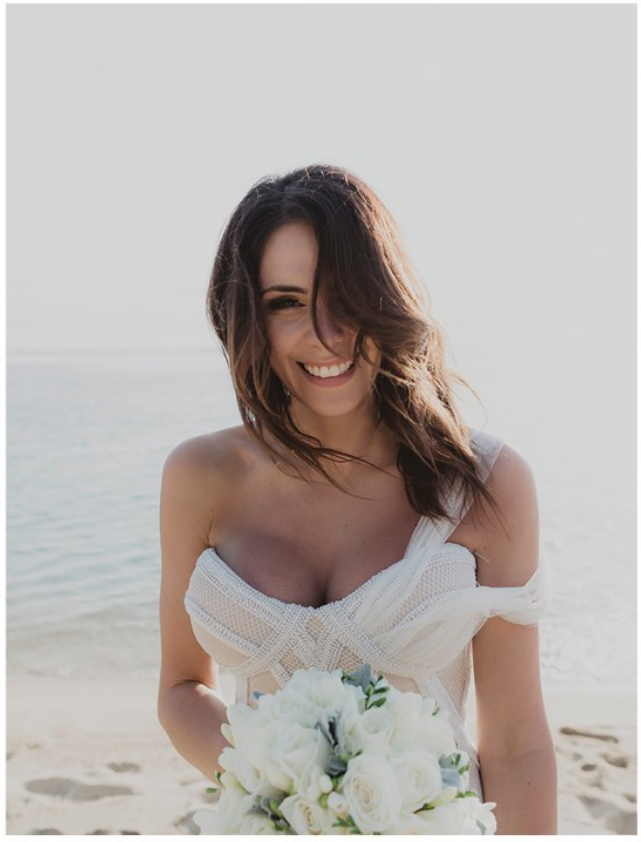
